## Program Notes

A kolo, which translates to round or circle, is a fast and lively traditional folk dance that originated in the Balkans. The music accompanying a kolo dance is characteristically quite repetitive. The primary melodic material is introduced at the beginning, and it continues to appear and reappear throughout the duration of the dance. Several composers, including Antonín Dvořák, have adapted the kolo into concert pieces for orchestra. These are often fast and exhilarating showpieces that portray the virtuosity of the entire ensemble. My piece, Kolo, continues this concert adaptation tradition, and it follows the basic structure of the traditional dance with the exception of the middle section. I was fortunate to spend about two weeks in Zagreb and several days in Dubrovnik during the spring of 2009.

Looking out upon the Adriatic Sea atop of Dubrovnik's historic city wall, I was struck by an overwhelming sense of tranquility, and that feeling has become the strongest association I have with my time in Croatia. In order to depict this musically, I forewent the continuation of the fast and lively character of the middle section of my Kolo and instead replaced it with music that is peaceful and reflective. The melody used in this slow section comes from a folk song, "Oj, mladano mlado mom(če)," in Béla Bartók and Albert B. Lord's folksong collection Serbo-Croatian Folk Songs. This middle section was my chance to return, if only in my mind, to the Adriatic coast.

## Program Notes

- The solo starting in measure 17 is originally intended to be played by baritone saxophone, however cues have been placed in the score and parts to allow other instruments to play this line. Regardless of instrument chosen, it should still be played by only one instrument.
- The word "solo" has been placed in several parts throughout the piece. It has two meanings. One, only one player should play this line (especially if doubling parts) and two, it is the primary material. The word "tutti" negates "solo."
- The ending tempo at Rehearsal K is meant to be fast. It is encouraged that if the ensemble can play this section fast, that they go ahead and do so.
